- White, blue, grey, or silver paper
- Scissors
- Glue

- Pencil
- Thread, yarn, thin string, or fishing line

INSTRUCTIONS:

- **1.** Gather your supplies from above. Use the template on the next page, or follow the instructions below...
 - **a.** Take the paper and fold one corner across the paper to the opposite corner to create a square.
 - **b.** Fold the paper diagonally in half to create a triangle. Fold the triangle again to form a smaller triangle.
 - **c.** Try your best to divide the triangle into three equal sections marking it from the point of the triangle with the pencil.
 - **d.** Once you have marked out the three equal sections, fold the left section towards the front and fold the right section towards the front.
 - e. Flip the shape over so that the side with the horizontal edge is facing front.
 - f. While keeping the sides folded, cut out random shapes out of the edges.
 - g. Carefully unfold the paper to reveal your snowflake.
 - **h.** Repeat the activity making different shapes in step 9. No snowflake is alike! They are all unique!
