SUPPLY LIST:

Recipe 1:

- 1 1/2 cup of baking soda
- 1/4 cup of white hair conditioner
- Measuring cups and bowl
- Spoon (for mixing)

Recipe 2:

- 1 1/4 cup of baking soda
- 1/2 cup of foamy shaving cream (chilled in fridge)
- Measuring cups, spoon, & bowl

Recipe 3:

- 1 cup of baking soda
- 1/4 cup of water
- A pinch of white glitter
- Measuring cups, spoon, & bowl

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Look at the recipes above and identify which of those supplies you have in your house.
2. Gather all of the supplies for the Fake Snow recipe you selected.
3. Follow the instructions below for the recipe you are making.
4. Lastly, play with the Fake Snow you make! Build a mini-snowman or make snowballs. It's your very own Snow Day!

RECIPE 1:

3. Add the water to the bowl.
4. Mix and place in freezer for 10 minutes.

DO YOU WANT TO BUILD A SNOW... FLAKE?!



SUPPLY LIST:

- White, blue, grey, or silver paper
- Scissors
- Glue
- Pencil
- Thread, yarn, thin string, or fishing line

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Gather your supplies from above. Use the template on the next page, or follow the instructions below...
 - a. Take the paper and fold one corner across the paper to the opposite corner to create a square.
 - b. Fold the paper diagonally in half to create a triangle. Fold the triangle again to form a smaller triangle.
 - c. Try your best to divide the triangle into three equal sections marking it from the point of the triangle with the pencil.
 - d. Once you have marked out the three equal sections, fold the left section towards the front and fold the right section towards the front.
 - e. Flip the shape over so that the side with the horizontal edge is facing front.
 - f. While keeping the sides folded, cut out random shapes out of the edges.
 - g. Carefully unfold the paper to reveal your snowflake.
 - h. Repeat the activity making different shapes in step 9. No snowflake is alike! They are all unique!
2. Use the thin string and tie it to the snowflake and add it to your Christmas tree or hang it up from your chimney.

DO YOU WANT TO BUILD A SNOW... FLAKE?!



Cut out the square. Fold diagonally in half to make a triangle. Fold once more in half to make a smaller triangle. Fold the left section toward the back. Fold the right section toward the back. Cut away the gray area. Unfold to reveal the snowflake.
