

PINECONE PENGUIN



SUPPLY LIST:

- Pine cones
- Black and yellow felt
- Black craft paint
- White craft paint
- Paint brush
- Pencils
- 1" wooden beads
- String or twine
- Hot glue & hot glue gun

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Go outside and collect a few of the biggest and whole pine cones you can find. Each pine cone will be turned in to a Christmas ornament.
2. Gather all of the supplies listed above and place them next to your pine cones.
3. Use the white paint and paint the top of the pine cone tips white.
4. Paint your wooden beads white - give them at least two coats. Allow time for the beads to dry.
5. Draw the penguins' eyes and head in pencil.
6. Paint those in black.
7. Cut out pieces of black felt for the wings and yellow felt for the feet. (Tear-drop shaped: long for the wings, short for the feet.)
8. Hot glue the wings and feet to the pine cone.
9. Cut out a small triangle for the beak. Hot glue the beak on to the wooden bead.
10. Thread the twine through the penguin head (bead) and secure the end with a large knot.
11. Hot glue your bead to the pine cone.

- White copy paper
- Tape
- Markers
- Scissors

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Gather all of your supplies. Cut red and green slips of construction paper that are about 1.5 inch wide and as long as the sheet of paper.
2. Collect your markers and write on each of your paper slips a gift of kindness that you want to give to your family or friends. Below are some ideas to get you thinking:
 - a. Bake a Christmas snack/treat
 - b. Take out the trash
 - c. Make hot chocolate for a sibling
 - d. Smile all day to everyone you see
 - e. Make Christmas cards for your bus driver or teachers
 - f. Go through your toys and put some away to donate to kids in need
3. Create some of your own "gifts" of kindness for those you love dearly. Be creative!
4. Each day leading up to Christmas, complete a "gift" of kindness that you wrote out on a ring.
5. After you complete your gift of kindness, use the tape to create a ring and connect it to other rings creating a chain.
6. Each ring is a gift of joy, kindness, and happiness that you gave during the Christmas season so collect as many as you can!
