INSTRUCTIONS:

- Gather all of your supplies listed above. These are what you will be using to decorate your
 picture framed ornament to capture all of your favorite Christmas memories.
- 2. Draw and color designs on each of the blank popsicle sticks using festive Christmas colors.
- 3. Once the sticks are ready, ask your parent, leader, or guardian to help you hot glue them together to make a house shaped frame. (rectangle shape with a triangle on top)
- 4. Decorate this house for the holidays! Choose from the supplies you have to help get this house ready for Christmas. Glue on beads, buttons, candy canes, etc.
- 5. Then, ask your parent, leader, or guardian to print out a picture for the frame. You could even gift it to someone special!
- **6.** Tie some string to your picture frame and hang it from a limb on the Christmas tree to be an ornament.
- 7. If you have extra supplies, decorate more popsicle sticks but this time create a star or a new fun shape rather than a house!
