### Day 1, 10:00 AM

### **ACCOMMODATIONS**

WinShape Camps for families is blessed to be located at the beautiful Cohutta Springs Conference Center. The entire campus spans over 800 acres of north Georgia wilderness, and we are only on a small portion of it. We are tucked away, removed from outside distractions, surrounded by the beauty of God's creation. There are very few places better to connect and grow closer to the Lord as a family than this piece of Heaven on earth.

We offer hotel-style rooms, which are perched inside one of our two main buildings (Woodlands and Mountain Shadow). Each family will be assigned to one of our rooms that overlook a glistening 55-acre lake. All rooms have a queen bed for parents and a twin bunk bed for kids. An additional roll-away bed can be provided for families larger than four people. Amenities include comfortable (A/C, Indoor plumbing, etc.) and are furnished with dressers, bedding, and towels.

The majority of the events and activities for the Session will be located around Legacy Lodge.

This is just a short walk away from your room and walking provides another opportunity for you and your family to enjoy this beautiful setting.

### **OVERVIEW OF FAMILY ACTIVITIES**

Throughout the session, blocks of time will be set aside for you and your family to participate in a variety of activities, that is referred to as "Family Free-For-All". You will be able to float around to the activities of your choosing as a family unit, meaning that how you choose to spend these time blocks is totally up to you and your family. Some activities will be open for you to come and go as you please, and these will not have an instructor but will instead be self-led. Some will be scheduled classes at certain times that will require you to sign-up, and these activities will have leaders or facilitators. Here is a comprehensive list of all that will be offered:

### Adventure Excursions: Sign -Up Activities

• Air: Zip Line, Flying Chair, High Ropes Course • Water: Water Slide + Rope Swing

• Ride: Banana Boat

Please consider any health conditions such as heart issues, pregnancy, etc. before partaking in any activities. Sign-Ups are required for these specific activities, and will take place on the first day of Camp. All Adventure excursions have particular age and or weight requirements as well as safety risks to keep in mind before signing up for them.

### **Adventure Excursion Limitations:**

- Zipline: Harness must fit snugly around the legs & waist and 50 lb minimum and 250 lb maximum weight
- Flying Chair: Harness must fit snugly around the legs & waist. There is no weight limits.
- High Ropes Course: Participants must be 8 years old, and Harness must fit snugly around the legs & waist.
- Water Slide+ Rope Swing: Participants must be able to hold their own body weight.
- Banana Boat: Participants must be at least 8 years old to ride. Participants must be over 30 pounds and fit in life jacket to ride in the boat that pulls the Banana Boat. All children under 13 must wear a life jacket while riding in the boat.

### Family Free-For-All:

Archery, Axe Throwing, Basketball, Bingo, Board Games, Canoeing, Craft, Digital Photography, Fishing, Fitness Center, Football, Frisbee, Hiking, Lake Life, Mountain Biking\*\*, Paddle Boarding, Pickleball, Soccer, Trivia, Volleyball, Rockets, and Yard Games.

**MOUNTAIN BIKING:** While we do have a variety of bikes and helmets available for use during certain time blocks, please know that sizes and quantities are limited. So, you are more than welcome to bring your own bikes and helmets to utilize throughout your time at camp. Bikes can be ridden on designated campus roads. Trail riding is prohibited. Should you choose to do so, please note that helmets are required on campus, and WinShape Camps will not be held liable for any lost, stolen, or damaged property.
